Guest Instructors

Grand Master Scott (Sun Yeel) Seo (8th Dan)

Grand Master Scott is the oldest son of Grand Master In Sun Seo. He was born in Busan, Korea and started his martial arts training from early childhood in the headquarter dojang of Grand Master In Sun Seo.

Grand Master Scott has had over 40 years of Hapkido Training with both his father and his father's senior Masters and Grandmasters. He is an 8th Dan Hapkido Black Belt.



He is the General Secretary of the Hanminjok Hapkido Association, which oversees more than 500 member schools in Korea. He also travels regularly to support Hanminjok Hapkido Association member schools in Asia, Europe and Oceania. This is Grand Master Scott's 3rd visit to New Zealand and he also mentors our senior New Zealand black belts in advanced aspects of Hapkido.

Master Young Hwan Choi (7th Dan)

Master Choi is owner of the Moosa Hapkido Jeil Dojang located in Changwon City, South Korea. He has been running it for 20 years. His dojang and his students are an integral part of the city events and festivals that are held throughout the year. Master Choi's Dojang is a sister – dojang to the Upper Hutt Hapkido Academy and he has hosted New Zealand Hapkido team members on the 2015 and 2017 Korea trips



Master Choi is an integral member of the World Kido Federation / Hanminjok Hapkido Association and is also a member of the Association's Masters Demonstration Team for the Association's exhibitions and events.

He has over 30 years of Hapkido training and is 7th Dan Hapkido Black Belt. He is a member of Cultural Art Foundation of Changwon City and a member of National Police University Training Advisory Board.

- 1.30 PM – Awarding of Medals for the Self Defence.
- 1.35 PM – Junior Sparring (Medals will be awarded at end of this).
- 2.30 PM - Adult Sparring.
- 3.30 PM – Short break while we calculate places for the Oceania Cup.
- 3.45 PM – Awarding of Medals for Adult Sparring and Oceania Cup.

All NZ Hapkido competitors are to wear their schools uniform which is to include your patches.

World Kido Federation registered Black Belts may wear their Hanminjok Hapkido black uniforms if they wish to. Competitors from other styles are able to wear attire that you would normally wear for your own formal events and competitions.

You don't have to stay all day so if you are just doing patterns or self-defence for example you can leave after you have finished although places won't be announced and medals awarded until the end of each competition. If you are doing self-defence and/or sparring it will pay to arrive early as my timings are approximate.
